Pre-Workshop Practical Session 1

Martin Hilpert (Université de Neuchâtel)

“Statistical Methods in Language and Linguistic Research”

- Present and explain several statistical techniques that are useful for the quantitative analysis of linguistic data.
- Carry out basic statistical tests, including examples and problems.
- Introduce participants to multi-variate methods of analysis.
- Analyse natural data sets using the open-source software R.

Pre-Workshop Practical Session 2

Dawn Archer (University of Central Lancashire)

“Discourse Analysis: Exploring Data with WMatrix”

- Introduce participants to the USAS and CLAWS systems, via Wmatrix3.
- Explain how Wmatrix can be used to undertake a variety of quantitative studies, using modern and historical datasets.
- Discuss the strengths and weaknesses of Wmatrix3.
- Show the steps needed to pursue your own studies using the Wmatrix3 interface.
